2021 The 2021 Harrison Hill **VINTAGE** patiently reveals its lively, complex core that is packed full of fresh raspberry, tobacco leaf, burnt orange peel, and sous bois notes. The palate is delicate and silky, with flavors of red currant, truffle, and pomegranate that is lifted by the lovely oak undertones. There is an effortlessness to this elegant wine, led by the polished tannins and bright acidity, that ends with a memorable finish. This wine is easily adored in its youth but will truly sing after 10+ years in bottle.

WINEMAKING

Single Vineyard blend from Harrison Hill. Stainless steel fermented, 14-16 days on skins. Barrel aged 20 months in French oak (92% new). Bottle aged 10 months prior to release.
